

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to you to inform you of our current plans for **GCSE Results Day on 20th August**.

To manage social distancing and ensure everyone gets their results safely, we are using the appointment system set out below. Please be aware that students must only arrive at their allotted time slot and that only the student can enter the building. Unfortunately, family and friends must remain in their cars and outside of the school site.

- Students must only arrive at their allotted time slot.
- On arrival, your child should arrive at the delivery to the school, in the car park by the main hall, where they will queue keeping a safe distance from other students using the markers outside of school.
- There, your child will be invited into the main hall and directed to a given 'station', where they will be given their results by a member of staff and some paperwork to fill in.
- They will exit the main hall, via another exit where will be staff on hand to help and support children with their next steps and give any advice we can.

If a student is unable to collect their results for any reason, we can arrange for someone else to pick them up, as long as we know in advance and have signed permission from the student (this is normal practice).

A – B	8.30am – 9am
C – D	9am – 9:30am
E – H	9:30 – 10am
I – N	10am – 10:30am
O – S	10:30 – 11am
T – Z	11am – 11:30am

If tighter restrictions are put in place between now and Results Day we may need to alter these plans and distribute results by email with follow up phone calls. Equally, if restrictions loosen and we can allow more people in the building we will adjust our plans accordingly as we are acutely aware that students want their friends and family close at hand on occasions like this. In either of these eventualities occur we will contact you in advance.

All students who have applied to NE6 will receive an invitation to an appointment on **Enrolment Day Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August** to officially enrol on their courses and discuss any questions they may have. We also have a few spare appointments that can be



booked on Thursday should your child decide they would like to consider NE6 as their next step in education.

This has been a really difficult time for our Year 11 students and no other Year 11 group in our memory have had a situation like this. We hope so much that following their results, they are able to enjoy the rest of the summer and look forward to their Post-16 learning or next steps.
