As a pupil of Ashington Academy, you are entitled to receive high quality Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance (CEIAG).

Your CEIAG programme will help you:

- Understand more about yourself, your likes and dislikes, your strengths and how this may affect your future career choices.
- Develop skills you need for working life.
- Develop a plan of action for the future, with realistic but ambitious targets.
- Understand about all the different post-16 and post-18 education.
- Understand different careers that are available and what qualifications and skills you will need to be successful.
- Write a CV and job application and develop interview techniques.

You will receive:

- CEIAG lessons as part of a wider PSHE programme during form time.
- Careers focussed lessons across the curriculum at various points throughout the academic year.
- At least two careers' interviews with a qualified careers advisor before you finish your GCSE's, and another in Sixth Form should you choose to stay with
- Work experience placements in year 10 and 12.
- Encounters with local further education providers before you leave in year 11.
- Access to employers and alumni from a range of organisations.
