Dear parent or carer,

Starting next week, all Year 11 students will be invited and encouraged to attend a session on a Tuesday and Thursday from 3.10pm to 4.00pm. This forms an important part of our ongoing support programme for Year 11 students.

These sessions will be targeted to the needs of the specific students in each group and will aim to fill any gaps that may exist.

Some students will use these initial sessions to work towards completing coursework or controlled assessment to the highest standard to give the students the best possible chance to achieve success. All sessions will be conducted in line with examination board guidelines.

Other students will be attending sessions in non-coursework subjects which are designed to provide structured, focused support in a quiet and productive environment. These will allow students to consolidate key knowledge and skills, as well as address any areas of difficulty with teacher guidance. In the first instance these sessions will be in English, Maths, Science and coursework or NEA completion.

Students have been allocated a subject group based on their current progress in school and the recommendation of teaching staff. Your child will be told in school which session they should attend in advance, and we will also be on hand to remind them each day.

We ask that, as parents and carers, you support us in encouraging your child to attend so that we can ensure they achieve their full potential this academic year.
